

MGA SUMMER CAMP

2026 Camp Policies & Procedures

This document outlines important policies for MGA Camps. Our goal is to provide a safe, fun, and well-organized camp experience for all campers.

Please review the information below carefully.

REGISTRATION & FEES

Please make sure all information, including parent/guardian information, is completed in your portal account, including emergency contacts and alternate contact phone number.

SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM FEE:

A one-time \$20 Summer Camp Program Fee applies to all students registered for Summer Camp.*

- *Program Fee is waived for campers ACTIVELY enrolled in Summer Class Program.
- This fee covers members attending CampMGA for all 9 weeks in Summer 2026.
- Students enrolling in Summer Classes AFTER enrolling in CampMGA will receive a \$20 credit towards class tuition.

REGISTRATION:

- Camp Registration launches on March 15th, 2026.
- All students joining any of MGA's programs must create a member account and have a valid credit card on file. Member link: [Create an online account](#)
- Summer Camp Registration may be easily completed through your [Parent Portal](#). Feel free to contact our office by email or call for any questions or concerns.

WALK-IN POLICY:

- Walk-ins will be accepted **based on daily availability**. MGA reserves the right to limit or DECLINE walk-in participation at the Camp Director's discretion.

- Walk-ins will incur an additional \$10 fee per student/day (Half or full day) to secure a same-day spot.
- All required waivers and registration forms must be **completed prior to participation.**
- Space is limited and priority is given to pre-registered campers.

PAYMENT:

- All Summer Camp payments are due in full at time of registration.
 - MGA families signing up multiple students or for multiple weeks are welcome to reach to our office for special circumstance payment options to be granted on a case-by-case basis.
 - Payments will be reviewed and cards on file will be auto-charged if full payment has not been received. If the payment method on file is declined, our office staff will make every effort to contact you. If we are unsuccessful, please note your registration may be cancelled and camper will be dropped from camp.
 - MGA accepts Visa, MasterCard, check or cash.
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CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

To ensure proper staffing, and camp preparation, the following payment and cancellation policies apply to all Summer Camp registrations:

MOST IMPORTANT:

- **No refunds or credits will be issued once a camp week has begun.**
- **Failure to attend camp does not qualify for a refund or credit.**
- **There are NO MAKE UPS for missed camp days.**

CANCELLATION POLICY:

- All cancellations must be received in writing at info@meadowlandsgym.com
- Cancellations made 30 or more days prior to the first day of the registered camp week are eligible for a full refund to the original form of payment.

- Cancellations made 29 to 8 days prior to the first day of the registered camp week are eligible for a full account credit minus a \$100 administrative fee.
- **Cancellations made fewer than 8 days prior to the first day of camp are not eligible for refunds or credits.**

MEDICAL EXCEPTION:

- In the event of injury or illness preventing participation, a credit may be issued with a valid doctor's note.
- **Documentation must be submitted PRIOR TO OR DURING the scheduled camp week.**
- Credits will be issued to the family account and may be applied toward future MGA programs.

CREDITS:

- Credits are non-transferable and have no cash value.
- Credits may be applied toward future camps, classes, or special programs at Meadowlands Gymnastics Academy.
- All credits must be used within 12 months of issue unless otherwise specified.

DROP-OFF & PICKUP

- Drop-off begins at 8:50am for all camps.
- Campers must be signed in and out everyday!
- Pick up is 3:00pm sharp! Please arrive on time for pick-up. Campers picked up more than 10 minutes late will be charged the late pick-up fee.
- Parents will be contacted if pickup is delayed beyond scheduled camp hours.

EARLY DROP-OFF and LATE PICKUP PROGRAM:

- MGA provides an early drop-off and late pickup program for our camp members at an additional cost.
- Early Drop-off: \$15/student per day

- Late Pickup: \$15/student per day
 - Campers will be hanging out in the lobby and are not permitted in the gym without supervision. We recommend sending a quiet activity such as a book or small craft to help keep your child comfortably occupied during that time.
 - Campers remain supervised at all times.
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LUNCH, WATER AND SNACKS

WATER & SNACKS:

- Full AND half day campers should bring lunch, snacks and plenty of water (we recommend 8oz per hour). We cannot refill water bottles.
- Please be sure to label all lunches & drinks with your child's name.
- MGA also has vending machines that may be accessed during camp.

PIZZA and ICE CREAM DAILY:

- Pizza and Ice Cream is available for purchase every day!
 - Pizza MUST be ordered daily upon drop-off and paid in cash.
 - \$3.50 per slice. 2 slices for \$6.00 (2026)
 - Ice Cream: Students may choose to order ice cream during lunch and pay in cash at time of purchase. We recommend providing your camper with \$ 'singles' if purchasing ice cream.
 - Cost is \$1.00-\$3.00 depending on choice.
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MEDICATION POLICY

MEDICATION POLICY:

- MGA staff may administer medication to a camper only with a completed [Medical Administration Consent Form](#).

- All medication must be clearly labeled, in its original packaging, and handed directly to the camp director.
 - We do not allow children to carry or self-administer medication unless explicitly authorized on the form.
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DRESS CODE and LOST & FOUND

DRESS CODE:

- CampMGA follows all general [MGA dress code policies](#).
- PLEASE SEND YOUR CHILD WITH LACED SNEAKERS! Laced sneakers are required to utilize the ninja course. Campers who do not have sneakers will not be able to participate on the ninja course.
- Fun Fridays are a water day outside (weather permitting). **Please send your child with a change of clothes every Friday.**
- We recommend always sending your camper with a change of clothes!

LOST & FOUND:

- MGA's Lost & Found bin lives above the white cubbies by the vending machines.
 - Please note we donate all items in our Lost & Found at the end of each month.
 - Please do not send your child with valuable items!
 - MGA will not be held responsible for lost or stolen items.
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PARENT LOBBY POLICY

PARENT LOBBY POLICY:

- CampMGA is a drop-off program. For the safety and independence of all campers, parents and guardians are not permitted to remain in the lobby during

the camp day. Once campers are signed in, they are under the supervision of MGA staff.

- Exception: On the first day of camp, we may allow brief accommodations for new campers on a case-by-case basis.
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CAMPER AGE & BATHROOM POLICY

CAMPER AGE & BATHROOM POLICY:

- CampMGA is open to children ages 4yrs and up.
 - Campers must be fully potty trained. Accidents happen from time to time, and our MGA staff will help our little ones with care and discretion.
 - Per MGA policy, bathroom assistance is always provided by a same-sex coach with additional staff nearby.
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INJURY & SAFETY

INJURY & SAFETY:

- If a camper is injured or requests ice, staff will respond immediately and monitor the camper.
 - Parents are informed of all injuries at pickup and contacted immediately if a situation escalates. **Please make sure your contact is up to date in your Parent Portal!**
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DAILY CAMP STRUCTURE

DAILY CAMP STRUCTURE:

- Each camp day includes structured gymnastics and ninja rotations, snack time, lunch, supervised play, and age-appropriate activities.
- Schedules may vary based on enrollment and staffing.
